

WATER COMMENTS

- Meter each home and read them internally. Turn over to City for billing
- Itemize statements to include Clubhouse, Pools, Common Area, Water, etc. Reduce dues by more than \$25.
- Put meters on homes with pools.
- Some homeowners have need to water common area that is not currently irrigated so their water bills would be higher.
- Install meters on homes with a guaranteed reduction in dues based on 2010 monthly cost.
- Install compromise meters so we can spot leaks and watch over our own usage. Learn to read our own meters and have a goal usage.
- Suggest owners of pools/saunas contribute to water bill voluntarily. Educate water users to be more aware of consumption.
- Install meters on high usage meters and study results. Some homeowners must water trees and other vegetation and that's ok.
- Keep current meters but charge the homeowners on that meter only for their share of that meters water usage.
- Impossible to have an opinion on such a vague problem.
- Do a trial with 3-4 meters at locations which use largest amount of water for at least 6 months. Do more research.
- Develop and implement a conservation plan for both HOA common areas and homeowners to reduce cost of water/sewer rather than just redistributing and increasing actual cost.
- More thought and investigation should be considered before any action is taken.

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
